However, the diabetes team would like to work to a hybrid model (NICE and EASD/ADA consensus guidance). The current NEL/NL guidance is based on the EASD/ADA guidance. The main difference would be place in therapy for GLP-1 inhibitors being used 2nd line after first line therapy with metformin plus SGLT2 inhibitor. NICE did not complete a full review at last review and did not recommend GLP-1 Ix for patient with diabetes and cardiovascular disease. The timeline for the full medicines update from NICE is TBC. KMc raised that NYY APC are also currently reviewing their diabetes guidance have looked at costing for GLP-1 inhibitors as second line therapy in this.
