Traffic Light Classification within HAPC:

RED - specialist prescriber only

AMBER SCF— prescribed in accordance with approved shared care framework

AMBER 2 (Specialist initiation and stabilisation) – initiated and stabilised by specialist

AMBER 1 (Guideline or Specialist Led) – prescribed on advice of specialist or in line with national / local guideline

GREEN – other items listed on formulary suitable for initiation and prescribing by any prescriber

PURPLE to be supplied from the appropriate commissioned prescriber

The Humber APC was formed in April 2022 merging Hull and East Riding Prescribing Committee (HERPC) and Northern Lincolnshire Area Prescribing Committee. The joint formulary alignment is currently ongoing with the joint formulary being hosted on the Northern Lincolnshire APC netFormulary website. Further details on the different classifications are at the end of the newsletter.

- Hull and East Riding of Yorkshire joint formulary users should still refer to the HERPC joint formulary first and then if directed within the formulary check the Humber APC formulary.
- Northern Lincolnshire users can continue to use the netFormulary website as normal.
